Which Drug?

Reverses an opioid overdose	Cannot be abused or cause an overdose	Temporarily takes away the "high"
Works in 1 to 3 minutes and lasts 30-90 minutes	Self administration difficult during overdose	Knocks opiate off receptor, but drugs are still in the body
Has no side effects	Stay with the person or transfer care to emergency personnel	Overdose can return

Is used to prevent and treat wheezing, shortness of breath, coughing, and chest tightness caused by lung diseases such as asthma and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD; a group of diseases that affect the lungs and airways).
